Howard A. Schmidt has had a 40-year distinguished career in defense, law enforcement and corporate security. He has served as Vice President and Chief Information Security Officer and Chief Security Strategist for online auction giant eBay. He most recently served in the position of Chief Security Strategist for the US CERT Partners Program for the National Cyber Security Division, Department of Homeland Security. He retired from the White House after 31 years of public service in local and federal government. He was appointed by President Bush as the Vice Chair of the President's Critical Infrastructure Protection Board and as the Special Adviser for Cyberspace Security for the White House in December 2001.



Fred Burton, one of the world's foremost authorities on security, terrorists and terrorist organizations, will discuss managing security in a changing environment. In the fast-paced information age, the workplace, the workforce and the way people work is changing at an accelerating pace. The threat environment posed by terrorists, criminals and hackers is also rapidly changing.

Come attend his Tuesday, May 15, morning keynote session to learn how to manage your security program in this environment with an eye toward using common sense and practical security measures to keep your people, information and other assets safe.

Mr. Burton acted as a special agent in counterterrorism for the U.S. Department of State, where he was instrumental in many high-profile operations. In addition, Mr. Burton has revolutionized the field of security by designing a unique and specialized protective program to safeguard CEOs, their families, employees, and physical facilities.
